MUSICAL ENSEMBLES

Our camp offers three major ensembles in which you may participate. Details of each ensemble are listed Below:

Marching Band

The Marching Band portion of the camp is designed to provide instruction in show-style marching band performance. The music selected for this ensemble includes but is not limited to popular music from the top of today's charts. As a culminating activity, the Marching Band is featured during an exhibition Performance in Armstrong Stadium.

Symphonic Band

The Symphonic Band is designed to expose students to Symphonic Band literature often found in high school symphonic and concert ensembles. In addition, the Symphonic Band focuses on then development and enhancement of musical fundamentals to include warm-up techniques, scales, etudes, and ensemble balance and blend exercises. As a culminating activity, the Symphonic Band will perform a concert at the end of the camp featuring the literature studied throughout the week.

Jazz Band

The Jazz Band consists of student musicians dedicated to performing in the popular jazz idioms. There are opportunities for solo playing, improvisation, and small combo-style instruction.

Applied Lessons

As a supplement to the instruction given during the camp, private applied instruction is also offered for an additional cost. These applied lessons will provide exposure to new literature and will help improve technical mastery on their particular instrument. Students taking applied study are encouraged to perform in a music recital toward the end of the week.

Auxiliary Instruction

In association with the Marching Band, students in auxiliary units are given instruction with a qualified instructor or group of instructors for their particular unit. Instruction is offered for the following auxiliary units:

- Flag Corps
- Dancers
- Drum Majors

Director's Clinic

In conjunction with the band camp, a clinic is offered for band directors. Participants will be afforded opportunities to interact with the camp directors, coordinators, and special guest clinicians. Topics of discussion include rehearsal techniques, composing and arranging, show design, band program administration, and instrumental methodology. Participants will also have the opportunity to instruct, council, and perform in the various ensembles of the camp.
