- [AIFS Study Abroad Scholarships & Grants](#) (\$250-\$5000, up to 50% of program fee; Grants \$200-\$1000)
- [Benjamin A. Gilman International Scholarship](#) (up to \$5000, additional \$3000 possible if studying a Critical Language). For Pell Grant recipients only. Preference for non-traditional students and non-traditional study abroad locations. Semester and summer scholarships available. The first Tuesday of March and October are the application deadlines. The HU Campus Benjamin A. Gilman Scholarship Advisor is Dr. Karima Jeffrey.
- [Benjamin Franklin Travel Grant](#) (\$1500) For students enrolled in a double major program combining a major/certificate in French and a major in another discipline. Open to sophomores, juniors, and seniors.

Intended for long-term study abroad and students committed to seek work in the federal government for a specified amount of time after graduation.
