## Concurrent Pre-requisites

Please note: If you sign up for a concurrent class that has a pre-requisite that you are currently taking, and you do not pass it with the required grade, then the computer system will automatically drop the class.

## HUNet Passwords

Please make sure you keep up with your HUNet password. This is the same password you will use throughout your matriculation. To ensure security, the Registrar's Office cannot provide this number via the telephone.

Advisement PINS are issued by the major department that is declared in the system. If this information is incorrect, fill out a Change of Major Form and submit an advisor approved Course Request Form to the Registrar's Office. The Registrar's Office cannot give you your advisement PIN without proof that you have been advised.

## Holds

Please check your local off-campus address and emergency contact information on HUNet and make any corrections before pre-registration begins. Students with a health hold, local or permanent address hold, emergency contact hold, or traffic violation will not be allowed to pre-register until the holds have been removed.

## Fall 2022 Early Registration

Advising for Early Registration begins on March 14, 2022.
